 - ◆ Check out time 1:00 p.m.
- ◆ Swimming pool hours are posted at the pool

CHECK-OUT TIME: In order to be fair to other campers with reservations, the 1:00 p.m. check-out time must be observed. If, however, you find camping at Hartney Campground as enjoyable as we hope you will and decide to stay longer than you indicated when registering, please notify the campground office as quickly as possible so that we may try to accommodate your request.

DRIVING & SPEEDING: PLEASE DRIVE SAFELY! Children are playing in the area and simply do not watch for traffic. The speed limit is 15 km per hour and violators will be reported to the R.C.M.P.

PARKING: Only 1 vehicle per site. No exceptions. Extra vehicles must be parked in the parking lot at the front of the pool building.

GARBAGE: Please help us to keep our park clean. There are garbage cans in several areas for your use. (see recycling sheet for more information)

OPEN FIRES: Each campsite has a designated fire ring to use for campfires. Please do not attempt to move the rings. Firewood is provided at no cost. It is located in the corner of the campsites.

PETS: We understand that pets are part of your family and they are welcome here. Please be sure that they are kept under control at all times and on a leash. Please be sure to scoop up after your pet, you might be the unlucky one to step in it!! Animal Control By-Law #882/99



VANDALISM: All vandals will be held responsible for damages to the Campground or Swimming Pool.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: The use of alcoholic beverages must be confined to each campers assigned space. Noisy campers (whether they are drinking or not) are going to be asked to be quiet. This is a family campground and therefore all language should be decent. Please keep beverage containers at your site. Bare feet are easily cut by broken bottles. If you accidentally break a bottle, please clean it up immediately.



SWIMMING POOL: The hours of operation for the swimming pool are, Monday - Friday 1-5 & 7-9. Saturday & Sunday Noon-5 and 7-9. The pool is tarped at night to conserve heat and chemical balance. Often acid is added at night and the water is not safe for at least 8 hours. Any person caught inside the pool after hours will be charged with trespassing. This is extremely dangerous and could lead to disaster. *Trespassers will be prosecuted.*

NUMBER OF CAMPERS: Each campsite is limited to one family or 6 people per site.

POLICING: The local R.C.M.P. detachment patrols the campground on a regular basis. Anyone found in violation of the campground rules will be asked to leave and may be fined depending on the offense.

QUIET TIMES: As this is a family campground, we ask that everyone observe the Quiet Times between 11:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. If you have visitors at your campsite, please respect others and talk in quiet tones. Unruly visitors will be asked to leave. No Loud Music will be allowed during quiet times. Noise By-Law #883/99.

BOOKINGS: No one under the age of 18 may book a campsite. Parents booking a site for their minor children must be camping with them.
